**Student deadline: October 11**

**Participant Eligibility Criteria:** A student's visual acuity must fall within the B1 through B2 classification range as defined by the United States Association of Blind Athletes.

**Class B1:** No light perception in either eye up to light perception, but inability to recognize the shape of a hand at any distance or in any direction. *A student may participate in a separate category as a B1 w/sleepshade.*

**Class B2:** From ability to recognize the shape of a hand up to visual acuity of 20/600 and/or a visual field of less than 5 degrees in the best eye with the best practical eye correction.
